

Emerging Scholarship Application - Investing in a New Generation

The American Baptist Churches of New Jersey is committed to mentoring and developing leaders to be ready and relevant for the future. This is one reason why we provide Emerging Scholarships. The leadership development and mentoring of a new generation of ecclesial leadership is critical. This is why we also provide scholarships for seminarians. These scholarships are provided to persons from ABCNJ churches in *covenant** with the region. Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate or professional degree program from an accredited institution: (two or four years) Associate, Bachelor of Arts/Science or Master of Religious Education (M.R.E.) or Master of Divinity (M.Div.) or equivalent.

You are strongly recommended to participate in and respond to e-mail requests and leadership development and mentoring events associated with the Emerging Scholars Program.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS (New and Returning Emerging Scholars)

Applicants must submit a **complete** 5-part application and include all required documentation listed below, or your application **will not be reviewed**. All documentation must be submitted on or before **April 30, 2024**. **Application submission does not guarantee an award**.

Application Form

- 1. Two letters of recommendation from the following:
 - 1. Pastor (printed on the church's letterhead) Your church must be in **covenant*** with the Region.
 - 2. Professor, Teacher or Guidance Counselor or Academic Advisor
- 3. A copy of your transcript that includes your Spring 2024 grades
- 4. Submit a resume that includes your involvement in school, church, community, and internships.
- 5. Choose one of the following essay topics to write about. The length of the essay should be 500 words (about 2 pages, typed and doubled spaced). Times Roman Font 12 pt. Please include your name/church/date and topic of essay. If you are a returning applicant, make sure you select a new essay topic.
- a) Describe your most meaningful achievement and how it relates to your field of study and future goals. Include how your faith has influenced your goals.
- b) As defined by Merriam-Webster, "Character is the way someone thinks, feels, and behaves." Essentially, it's what makes you who you are. Describe a time in your life that has shaped who you are as a person. Include how your faith has shaped who you are
- c) If you had the opportunity to change your school, community or church in a positive way, what specific changes would you make and why? How does your faith impact the way you think and go about changes?
- d) How has your church and family background impacted your faith and the way you see the world?
- e) Describe an event in (school, church or community) in which you took a leadership role. What did you learn about yourself? What leadership characteristics did you exemplify? What role did your faith play in your leadership?

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: (New and Returning Seminarians)

Applicants must submit a **complete** 5-part application and include all required documentation listed below, or your application **will not be reviewed**. All documentation must be submitted on or before **April 30, 2024**. **Application submission does not guarantee an award**.

- 2. Two letters of recommendation from the following:
 - 1. Pastor (printed on the church's letterhead)
 - 2. Professor, Academic Advisor
- 3. A copy of your transcript that includes you Spring 2024 grades
- 4. Submit a resume
- 5. Choose one of the following essay topics to write about. The essay must be at least 750 words, (about 3 pages typed and double-spaced), Times Roman Font -12 pt. Please include your name/church/date and topic of essay. If you are a returning applicant, please select a new essay topic.
 - a) Please address your sense of call to ministry/vocation, your unique gifts for this ministry/vocation, and how a seminary education will assist you in meeting your vocational intentions.
 - b) Describe how your seminary education has impacted the way you lead and teach in your current ministry context.
 - c) Tell us about a time when you challenged your pre-existing worldview. Why? Would you do this again? Make sure that you share an example of how you can listen to experiences and perspectives contrary to your own with respect and maturity and how your faith impacts your pre-existing worldview.

Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Undergraduate - 8 ABCNJ Emerging Scholar awards in the amount of \$1,000 for full time students. Seminarian - 8 ABCNJ Emerging Scholar awards in the amount of \$1,500 for full time students.

Please note: If you are a part time student your award will be adjusted.

Scholarship recipients must enroll in and attend a two or four year college/university or seminary in the academic year following their selection. Verification of enrollment is required (i.e. tuition receipt, letter from the registrar's/bursar's office, class schedule certifying enrollment).

Scholarship awards will be paid via check directly to the accredited institution in which the student enrolls. *Awards will NOT be paid directly, nor reimbursed to an award recipient.*

Scholarship applications and all requested documents must be received at the ABCNJ office no later than <u>April 30, 2024</u>. <u>Incomplete applications will not be reviewed</u>.

*Applicants are responsible for consulting with their pastor to ensure their church is in covenant with the American Baptist Churches of New Jersey. *Sponsoring churches must be in covenant with ABCNJ. This* includes giving to either United Mission and/or ABCNJ Region Offering in 2022/2023 and participating in associational and regional events, such as the Annual Session. If your church is not in covenant, you will not be eligible for the scholarship. Call the ABCNJ office if you are not sure.
